The Purpose of the Smiths Station Fire Protection District shall be to provide fire protection and fire-based EMS services to the residents of the area served by the fire protection district.

ITEM FIVE

The authorizing subdivision(s) for the Smiths Station Fire Protection District is the County Commission of Lee County, Alabama, and the City Council of the City of Smiths Station, Alabama.

ITEM SIX

The application filed with the governing body of each of the authorizing subdivision(s) in accordance with <u>Code of Alabama 1975</u>, Section 11-89-3 was identical, and a copy is attached hereto.

ITEM SEVEN

The names of the persons forming the Corporation are:
Felton Adkinson, Earline Morris, Joseph Walden, Daniel Sexton,
Dwight Christopher, Clinton Knox, Billy Jones, and Ronald Cecil
Martin. (hereinafter the "Incorporators")

Each of the foregoing names persons herby state and certify they are over the age of 21 and a duly qualified elector of Lee County, Alabama.

ITEM EIGHT

The governing body of Lee County, Alabama has reviewed the contents of the Application filed by the named incorporators and has found and determined as a matter of fact that it is wise, expedient, and necessary that the proposed fire protection district be formed. As such the Lee County Commission adopted a resolution on February 28, 2022, authorizing the herein named Incorporators to proceed to form the Smiths Station Fire Protection District by the filing for record of a certificate of incorporation in accordance with the provisions of Code of Alabama, 1975, Section 11-89-4.

ITEM NINE

The governing body of the City of Smiths Station, Alabama has reviewed the contents of the Application filed by the named incorporators and has found and determined as a matter of fact that it is wise, expedient, and necessary that the proposed fire protection district be formed. As such the Smiths Station City Council adopted a resolution on February 22, 2022, authorizing the herein named Incorporators to proceed to form the Smiths Station Fire Protection District by the filing for record of a certificate of incorporation in accordance with the provisions of Code of Alabama, 1975, Section 11-89-4.

ITEM TEN

The Fire Protection District created hereby shall have and exercise all the power and authority grated for such pursuant to Code of Alabama, 1975, Section 11-89-1, et. seq. and such additional power and authority as is now or may hereafter be provided by law.

ITEM ELEVEN

The Fire Protection District created herby shall be governed by a Board of Directors. All powers of the said Fire Protection District shall be exercised by the Board or pursuant to its authorization.

The Board shall consist of five directors. Board members shall be appointed by the governing bodies of the Lee County Commission and Smiths Station City Council as follows:

- <u>Place 1:</u> Nominated by District 3 Commissioner; approved by simple majority vote of Lee County Commission.
- <u>Place 2:</u> Nominated by District 3 Commissioner; approved by simple majority vote of Lee County Commission.
- <u>Place 3:</u> Nominated by District 4 Commissioner; approved by simple majority vote of Lee County Commission.
- <u>Place 4:</u> Nominated by District 5 Commissioner; approved by simple majority vote of Lee County Commission.
- <u>Place 5:</u> Nominated by Mayor of Smiths Station; approved by simple majority vote of Smiths Station City Council

To allow for staggered terms the initial terms of each director shall be as follows:

Place 1: 2 years Place 2: 4 years Place 3: 3 years Place 4: 3 years

Place 5: 2 years

Thereafter the term of office for each Director shall be four years.

Each Director nominated by a governing body must be a duly qualified elector of that governing body and must be a resident of the area in which the Smiths Station Fire Protection District shall render fire protection services.

Each Director shall be reimbursed for expenses actually incurred in and about the performance of their duties. Each director shall be compensated in an additional amount as prescribed by the governing body of each authorizing subdivision. The chairman may be compensated in an additional amount as prescribed by the governing body of each authorizing subdivision.

Any director of the district may be impeached and removed from office in the same manner and on the same grounds provided by Section 175 of the Constitution of Alabama and the general laws of the state for impeachment and removal of the officers mentioned in said Section 175.

Application to Establish the Smiths Station Fire Protection District

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue was incorporated in the State of Alabama, County of Lee County as The Friendship Firefighters Association on September 29, 1966; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue was originally organized in the State of Alabama, County of Lee County, as a 501(c)4 non-profit social welfare organization for the purpose of providing Volunteer Fire & Rescue services to the community; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue is a Fire Department recognized by the Lee County Commission; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue is a Fire Department recognized by the City Council of the City of Smiths Station; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue is a Fire Department recognized by the Alabama State Fire Marshal; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue is a Fire Department recognized by the Lee County 911 Emergency Communications District; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue is a Fire Department recognized by the Alabama Forestry Commission; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue is a Fire Department recognized by the Alabama Fire College & Personnel Standards and Education Commission, which was established by the Code of Alabama 1975 § 36-32-2; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue services a response area in south east Lee County and the boundaries of the response area were originally defined by the Lee County Commission; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue response boundaries include the entirety of the City of Smith Station; and,

WHEREAS, a concise legal description of the Smiths Station Fire & Rescue response area has been prepared by a engineer licensed in the State of Alabama and is attached to this application as exhibit 99, as required by the Code of Alabama 1975 § 11-89-3 (a)(2)(i); and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue provides fire protection and rescue services 24 hours a day, 365 days a year inside the boundaries of its response area; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue is the primary first responding agency to Fire & Rescue calls inside its response area; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue provides automatic mutual aid for structure fires to 3 other fire departments in Lee County; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue provides mutual aid for fire & rescue calls to all other fire departments in Lee County when requested; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue provided mutual aid ambulance services and transport to all of Lee & Russell Counties when requested; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue is dispatched by the E911 PSAP located at the Lee County Sheriff's office; and,

WHEREAS, the population of Lee County was 49,754 in 1960 and is estimated to be 164,542 as of 2019 an increase of 331%; and,

WHEREAS, the population of the Smiths Station Fire response area is estimated to have been approximately 11,480 in 1964 and 39,000 as of 2022; and,

WHEREAS, the Lee County GIS department lists 14,086 addresses in the Smiths Station Fire & Rescue response area; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Smiths Station was incorporated on June 22, 2001; and,

WHEREAS, the estimated population of the City of Smiths Station is 5,391 as of 2019; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue answered approximately 25 calls for service per year in the 1960's; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue answered 2,899 calls for service in 2020; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue has grown from a small organization with a single station and fire engine to a large organization with 20+ volunteers, 6 Stations, 6 Engines, 1 Ladder Truck, 3 Brush Trucks, 1 Ambulance, and 3 quick response SUVs; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue is currently funded by a Fire Fee assessed by the Lee County Commission; and,

WHEREAS, the amount of this fire fee was set by a vote of the citizens within the Smiths Station Fire & Rescue response area in 2012; and,

WHEREAS, approximately 80% of the voters inside the Smiths Station Fire & Rescue response area voted to approve this fire fee in 2012; and,

WHEREAS, the cost of everything from electricity, to fuel, to vehicle maintenance, to Fire Engines & Medical Supplies and Turn Out Gear has increased substantially since 2012; and,

WHEREAS, the US Bureau of Labor Statics estimates that inflation has increased 14% since 2012; and,

WHEREAS, inflation as a result of the Covid-19 Pandemic has caused prices to rise at an even faster rate; and,

WHEREAS, the current fire fee does not include any provisions for increase; and,

WHEREAS, the current fire fee is not permanent funding, and is set to expire in 2037; and,

WHEREAS, the increased growth of the Smiths Station area has driven demand from the citizens within the Smiths Station Fire & Rescue response area for more and quicker responses as well as expanded services that typically are provided by larger "paid city" Fire Departments; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue has used the current fire fee to build or rebuild 3 stations, purchase a ladder truck and 3 fire engines; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue has a 1991 E-One fire engine that is beyond repair and urgently needs to be replaced; and,

WHEREAS, failure to replace this 1991 E-One fire engine will have a detrimental effect on the ISO rating of Smiths Station Fire & Rescue as well as the insurance premiums of the citizens within the response area; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue wishes to continue to modernize, grow, and to provide "city" level fire and rescue services to the citizens in the response area; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue wishes to become a "combination department" and have both paid firefighters and volunteer firefighters to insure availability as well as adequate and fast response at all times of the day and night; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue wishes to provide any paid firefighters and ambulance personnel with standard benefits such as a competitive salary, state retirement, and state health insurance; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue wishes to make substantial capital investments in both equipment, training, and facilities; and,

WHEREAS, the current fire fee does not provide adequate funding for personnel or additional equipment, training, or facilities; and,

WHEREAS, other fire departments in our area and within the State of Alabama are organized as Fire Protection Districts under the Code of Alabama § 11-89-1 et sq.; and,

WHEREAS, without additional funding Smiths Station Fire and Rescue will likely be forced to further reduce or eliminate services to remain solvent; and,

WHEREAS, any reduction or elimination of services would have extreme and lasting detrimental affects to both life and property within the response area; and,

WHEREAS, the current fire is not equitably applied, and does not distinguish between a single-family residence and an multifamily dwelling units, which results in an unfair and disproportionate fee system; and,

WHEREAS, the current fire is not equitably applied, and does not distinguish between a single-family residence and a commercial structure, which results in an unfair and disproportionate fee system; and,

WHEREAS, Smiths Station Fire & Rescue wishes to equitably charge proportionally higher rates for multi-family dwelling units and commercial structures, than it charges for single family residential structures; and,

WHEREAS, the Code of Alabama 1975 Chapter 11 Section 89 provides for the establishment of Fire Protection Districts; and,

WHEREAS, the Code of Alabama § 11-89-3(a) states: In order to incorporate a district under this chapter, any number of natural persons, not less than three, shall first file an identical written application with the governing body of each county and municipality located in whole or in part within the boundaries of the area or areas to be served by the proposed district; and,

WHEREAS, an identical copy of this application and all attachments has been or will be filed with both the City of Smiths Station and the Lee County Commission as required by the Code of Alabama 1975 § 11-89-3 (a); and,

WHEREAS, the Code of Alabama § 11-89-9 (a) states: The district shall have the following powers, together with all powers incidental thereto or necessary to the discharge thereof in corporate form: (10) To furnish and provide fire protection service in the service area or in any part thereof or to or on behalf of one or more counties, municipalities, or other public corporations upon such reasonable terms and for such reasonable rates and consideration as the board may prescribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Code of Alabama § 11-89-9 (a) states: The district shall have the following powers, together with all powers incidental thereto or necessary to the discharge thereof in corporate form: (24) To fix and revise from time to time reasonable rates, fees, and other charges for water service, sewer service, fire protection service, or any thereof, furnished or to be furnished by any water system, sewer system, or fire protection facility, or portion of any thereof, owned or operated by the district, and to collect all charges made by it; and,

WHEREAS, the Code of Alabama § 11-89-12 gives Fire Protection Districts the powers to: Establish and revise rates, fees, and charges for services rendered by district. And further states:

Rates, fees, and charges for fire protection service rendered by the district from any of its fire protection facilities shall be so fixed and from time to time revised as at all times to provide funds at least sufficient to:

- (1) Pay the cost of operating, maintaining, repairing, replacing, extending, and improving the systems and facilities or either from which such services are rendered;
- (2) Pay the principal of and the interest on all bonds issued and obligations assumed by the district that are payable out of the revenues derived from operation of those systems and facilities as the said principal and interest become due and payable;

- (3) Create and maintain such reserve for the foregoing purposes or any of them as may be provided in any mortgage and deed of trust or trust indenture executed by the district under this chapter or in any resolutions of the board authorizing the issuance of bonds, the assumption of any obligation or the acquisition of any such system or facility; and
- (4) Make such annual payments, if any, to the United States of America or any agency or instrumentality thereof, the state, municipalities, counties, departments, authorities, agencies. and political subdivisions of the state and any public corporations organized under the laws of the state as the district may have contracted to make; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors for Smiths Station Fire & Rescue met in at the regular meeting in March 23, 2021 and with a proper quorum present, unanimously voted in favor of establishing a Fire Protection District; and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with Code of Alabama 1975 § 11-89-3 (5) that each of the undersigned applicants is a duly qualified elector of the county of which such application is filed.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Directors and the undersigned hereby submit this document to serve as a written application to the Lee County Commission and the City of Smiths Station to create/establish the Smiths Station Fire Protection District as required by the Code of Alabama 1975 § 11-89-3 (a).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the current entity now known as Smiths Station Fire & Rescue along with all of its assets, accounts, real estate, personal property, and debts a shall be merged with and into the new Smiths Station Fire Protection District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Smiths Station Fire Protection District shall operate as Smiths Station Fire & Rescue.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, in accordance the Code of Alabama § 11-89-3 (1); that the purpose of the Smiths Station Fire Protection District shall be to provide fire protection service(s) within the boundaries of the response district herein described and under mutual aid agreements with other departments.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, in accordance with the Code of Alabama § 11-89-3 (2)(i), that the legal boundaries of Smiths Station Fire Protection District shall be the same as those currently defined for Smiths Station Fire & Rescue and that a concise legal description of those boundaries is attached to this document.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in accordance with the Code of Alabama § 11-89-3 (3) Code of Alabama, that the Board of Directors for the Smiths Station Fire Protection District will be made up of 5 Members, each serving 4-year terms.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in accordance with the Code of Alabama § 11-89-6:

- The terms of the Board Members shall be staggered in a 2-2-1 format
- The Lee County Commission shall appoint place 1-4 using the following method:
 - Board Member places 1-2 shall be nominated by District 3 Commissioner
 - Board Member place 3 shall be nominated by District 4 Commissioner
 - Board Member place 4 shall be nominated by District 5 Commissioner
 - All Nominees shall be confirmed by a vote of the County Commission as a whole

- The City of Smiths Station shall appoint place 5 using the following method:
 - Board Member place 5 shall be nominated by the Mayor
 - Nominee shall be confirmed by a vote of the City Council as a whole

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the proposed initial board members shall be:

Place 1: Felton Adkinson - 2 years

Place 2: Walter Cox - 4 years

Place 3: Todd Boatner - 3 years


Place 4: Joe Walden - 3 years

Place 5: Cecil Martin - 2 years

Should any position become vacated before the end of the term a successor shall be appointed to complete that term.

The board of directors shall have the authority to elect officers such as Chairman, Vice Chairman, Treasurer, and Secretary, as well as any other officers as the board feels necessary.

Unless otherwise specified by the laws of the State of Alabama all votes by the Board of Directors shall require a simple majority and each Director shall have one (1) vote.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, in accordance with the Code of Alabama 1975 § 11-89-3(4), The location of the principal office of the Smiths Station Fire Protection District shall be 50 Lee Rd 430, Smiths Station, AL 36877

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, in accordance with the Code of Alabama 1975 § 11-89-3 (6) the undersigned request that the Lee County Commission and the City of Smiths Station adopt a resolution declaring that it is wise, expedient, and necessary that the proposed district be formed and authorizing the applicants to proceed to form the proposed district by the filing for record of a certificate of incorporation in accordance with the provisions of Section §11-89-4.
